The President's Message

Dear Members,

The first three months of our fiscal year have been busy. During this short time we have done much – so let me take you through...

Our first session with General Practitioners (GPs) on the ground took off well in Kelantan. It was held on 28th July 2017 along with a CPD programme involving Dermatology. Dr Wan Hasbee, Consultant Dermatologist, from Hospital Raja Perempuan Zainab Il gave a talk on Common Skin Diseases in General Practice. The session was well attended by more than 100 participants from Kelantan. They were also given a briefing on AFPM and the advantages of membership by Datuk Dr. Sheikh Mohd Amin, our Dean of Graduate studies. The session was coordinated by Dr. Nurhayati bt Mohamad who is the AFPM chapter head for Kelantan, Dr Rahimi bin Sayutti of Klinik Primer Kota Bharu and Dr. Ilham Ameera Ismail of the AFPM Council. We were taken to the proposed site and formalities are on-going with the Land Office of Selangor. Other sites in Technology Park Malaysia (TPM) are being considered as well.

The accreditation visit by the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) that took place from 26-28 September, 2017 went well. Leading our team was Datuk Dr. Sheikh Mohd Amin and Dr. Emma F. Zulkifli our Censor in Chief. The documentation with reference to our training activities was scrutinized by the RACGP team that consisted of Dr Mark Miller and Dr Ken Wanguhu who were encouraging in their remarks. The formal feedback is expected shortly.

We recently lost a stalwart among our administrative staff. Mr K. Paridevan Kanagaratnam, the ATFM Manager passed away after a short illness on 14th September, 2017. We will miss him. A formal delegation from AFPM visited his family to extend our condolences.

RACGP ACCREDITATION VISIT

26-28 September 2017

As most of us are aware, AFPM went through an accreditation exercise of its training programmes that lead to the Conjoint MAFP/FRACGP Examination with the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) recently. RACGP sent two reviewers over, Dr Mark Miller, the RACGP Censor-in-Chief, as well as Dr Ken Wanguhu, RACGP Rural Censor.

RACGP reviewers met up with both GCFM and ATFM Directors, Prof Datin Dr Chia CY and A/P Dr Chandramani respectively on the first day. They also met with our President, Dr JP Kamalanathan and all EXCO members and interviewed Faculty Members comprising of the Dean of Graduate Studies Prof Datuk Dr Sheikh MA, Censor-in-Chief Dr Emma FZ, Chief Examiner Dr Tan Chow Wei, Chapter of Teachers Chairperson Dr Lili Zuryani and QIP Director Prof Kwa Siew Kim.

Both reviewers also held teleconference interviews with candidates going through the programme as well as repeat candidates.

Both RACGP reviewers were taken on practice site visits on the 27th September 2017 to meet candidates from both private and MOH clinics. Visits were made to KK Presinct 9 Putrajaya, KK Sg Selisek with its Klinik Desa Gedangsa, Klinik Warga Hospital Sg Buloh and Klinik Segara.

The visit ended on the 28th September 2017. RACGP will send a formal report of the outcome soon.

Graduate Certificate In Family Medicine (GCFM) 2017

The Academy of Family Physicians, Malaysia recognizes the need for training all General Practitioners to a level of competence in Good Medical Practice to meet the national healthcare delivery standards. AFPM has developed a two year (four semesters) distance learning program for Graduate Certificate in Family Medicine.

The objective of this Online Learning Programme is to provide flexibility in learning for all General Practitioners who meet the entry requirement.

The course delivers high level teaching materials covering all subject areas of interest to General Practitioners. With the Online tutorial support, Online assignment and MCQ test system, the student will be exposed to information technology and update their professional skills via the cyberspace community.

Upon completion of the GCFM programme, the candidate may continue studying by enrolling on the Advance Training in Family Medicine (ATFM) for two years to prepare for the Membership Examination of the AFPM and the Fellowship Examination of The Royal Australian College of General Practitioners. (MAFP/FRACGP)

The first semester will commence with the first four modules, which are to be completed each month. The first workshop will be held on the first week of the semester.

The one and half day workshop will consist of a half day E-Learning session, and followed with one day of Principle of Family Practices, Management of General Practice, Economics of General Practice and Quality Improvement Program.

The Advanced Training in Family Medicine (ATFM) Programme has been designed to train candidates who wish to acquire the qualification of Member of the Academy Family Physicians of Malaysia (MAFP) which is jointly awarded with the Fellowship of the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (FRACGP). This qualification is an entry qualification for gazettement to practice as a Family Medicine Specialist.
